Editorial

CYBER FRAUDS-SAFETY SAVES

In the ever evolving landscape of human progress, technology stands a formidable force that has reshaped our world. Its influence is omnipresent, touching nearly every aspect of our lives. However, the question persists "is technology a boon or bane?"



Technology has revolutionized health care, enabled instantaneous communication across vast distances, facilitated global collaboration and cultural exchange and economic growth and has demonstrated access to quality education. It has served like a catalyst for innovation and creativity.

Similarly, in banking sector, Digital banking has emerged as a transformative force, offering a wide range of benefits to busy individuals. By leveraging technology, Digital banking has revolutionized the way we handle our financial transactions.

However, at the same time the technology has provided room for frauds and security breaches in mobile and online platforms. There has been a sharp rise in cyber crimes and Indians, as per data available, have lost over Rs 176 crores to cyber criminals during the period Jan to April 24. The main target for cyber criminals are the senior citizens.

Keeping in view the gravity of situation, the bank convened a virtual meeting of representatives of all the SBIPAs to apprise them of various safety measures for the benefit of all the retirees. We also thought it fit to transmit the information to all our members to save them from such frauds.

The important guidelines for all the senior citizens are as under

- 1 Never download an application from an unknown source.
- 2 Never respond to a call from unknown sources offering work from home to retirees.
- 3 Never respond to a call stated to be from crime branch/police station.
- 4 Never make investments through link received through whatsapp.
- 5 Never respond or share OTP on a call purported to be from bank for KYC updation.
- 6 Never respond to calls/SMS regarding nonpayment of utility bills and major penalties.
- 7 Never share personal data on phone stated to be from bank for investments in Insurance schemes.
- 8 Never respond to a link for verification of income tax refund. Always log in to IT website.

9 Don't respond to a call asking you to refund the money erroneously deposited in your account.

10 Do not respond to call from your old friend who can not be recognised, demanding money urgently required by him.

11 In case of call received from bank it is advisable to disconnect and recall the bank or personally visit the branch to know the reality.

12 The national cyber crime helpline number 1930 can be contacted in case any help is required'

13 The siphoning out of funds from your account must be immediately reported to your branch as well as SBIPA representatives. Generally, the association is informed after availing of all the available avenues thereby making it very difficult to provide the necessary relief.

It has also been observed that people attacked by cyber criminals do not talk about the incident due to fear of losing self respect and the incidents go unreported and the criminals get encouraged.

We are always ready to help our members. However, "A stitch in time saves nine" works well here. We are sure, these awareness tips will save our members from digital frauds

HANDICAPPED CHILDREN OF PENSIONERS START ACQUIRING STATUS OF FAMILY PENSIONERS

The members will recall that on assuming office we took up the matter relating to the status of physically handicapped and mentally crippled children of pensioners with corporate Centre through Circle CGM. We are happy to inform that our continued efforts have proved successful as four of the cases have been approved by CC. We are sure to provide justice to other eligible cases too shortly.

STRUCTURED MEETINGS

Holding structured meetings with the management and getting the pensioners' issues resolved has become a permanent feature for SBIPA. We will be happy to receive suggestions, through local office bearers, for improvement in the lives of our members'

PROGRAM FOR RETIRING STAFF

The locally available office bearers of SBIPA Chandigarh Circle make are making it certain to participate in the captioned program now being held bi-monthly at SBILD Panchkula. The retiring staff is provided with tips for happy retired life and motivated to join SBIPA.

COMMUTATION OF PENSION

Members are well aware that the commutation factor in SBI is very inferior to what is available in other spheres. Now with Punjab Government pensioners filing a plaint in the Punjab & Haryana high court and getting stay against recovery of commuted pension after 10 years and 8 months, pensioners from various establishments have also starting approaching the court of law and getting stay orders. We had already taken up the matter with our federation as well as corporate centre through Circle authorities for improvement in commutation factor and reduction in recovery period. On the stay orders obtained by SBI pensioners petitioners, the CGM { Law } has opined that bank is not recovering commuted value of pension but only restoring the pension after 15 years under commutation of pension rules. The matter may come up in the future date of hearing. Members are requested not to panic as the federation will take appropriate steps to resolve the issue.

PERSONAL ALLOWNCE FOR 11TH BIPARTITE RETIREES

We are in receipt of representation from a few of the 11th bipartite retirees demanding special allowance in line with the same granted vide 12th bipartite settlement. The members are well aware that with each bipartite settlements there are improvements which cannot be extended to earlier retirees. The matter was discussed in governing body meeting of our federation and the clear opinion emerged was in line with aforementioned opinion. However, we will give a second thought and if considered fit, raise the demand with corporate centre.

ISSUES PERTAINING TO eSBOP RETIREES

The issues brought to our notice are receiving due attention. We are following up the issues on regular basis. Since, a large number of eSBOP retirees have not joined SBIPA and are dependent on their own associations, we are not in a position to take up forcefully with the management. We request our members from eSBOP to convince all those who have not yet joined our association to

immediately join SBIPA to ensure desired strength for taking up their issues strongly for early resolution. The Bank has agreed to convene a small committee meeting to discuss the issues of e - associate bank retirees on 7th October 2024

MWS SCHEME

The problems relating to non availability of funds for payments of family pension and reimbursement of medical expenses to the subscribers of captioned scheme is taken care of by us as and when required.

DISPENSARIES

We have taken up with the management for opening dispensaries at all RBO centres. The dispensary at Hissar stands approved and the appointment of doctor is in process. approval for opening of dispensaries at Kurukshetra, Hoshiarpur and Dharamsala will see lifght of the day soon. With this we will have dispensaries at all RBO centres in Haryana and J & K. In Punjab all RBO centres in Ludhiana are covered. A few of the centres in HP, Bhatinda and Mohali Modules viz Mandi, Hamirpur, Solan, Pathankot, Ropar, Barnala, Sangrur. and Muktsar still lack dispensaries. We have taken up with the management for early establishment of dispensaries at these centres.

Keeping in view the genuine demand of pensioners residing in Patiala, we have requested the management to establish a fully equipped dispensary in RBO building in addition to present dispensary at training centre with part time doctor. We are sure, the Patiala Pensioners will get it very soon.

On our request, the budget for Ambala dispensary stands enhanced from Rs8000 to Rs 50000 pm and a budget of Rs 50000 for Amritsar dispensary has also been sanctioned'

SUBMISSION OF LIFE CERTIFICATE

IDENTIFICATION OF PENSIONERS THROUGH VIDEO AS ON ALTERNATE METHOD

In terms of Regulation 17 of SBI Employee Pension Fund Regulation 2014, SBI pensioners are required to submit life certificate attested by Magistrate or any officer of the Bank or by a digital life certificate through video-based identification. Currently following facilities are available for the pensioners for submission of life certificate:

- Physical Submission of Life Certificate: Life certificate is submitted in person and signature is made in presence of the officer of the Bank.
- Facility to submit digital Life certificate: Facility for submission for Life Certificate is also available to the pensioners through "Jeevan Pramaan" an Aadhar based platform for biometric authentication of the pensioners.

2. In addition to above, it has been decided to introduce "Video based identification" for staff pensioners/ family pensioners for submission of life certificate. The additional facility will enable the staff pensioners/ family pensioners to submit the life certificate without visiting the Branch and will reduce the instances of discontinuation of pension.

3. The standard operating procedure for obtaining life certificates through "Video based identification" in myHRMS app is enclosed (Annexure I). The facility for staff pensioners is already rolled out and the functionality for photograph uploading & video-based submission of life certificate, declaration of Non-remarriage and Non-employment for family pensioners will be rolled out in due course and advised separately.

4. It has been decided by the appropriate authority that Video based life certificates submitted by staff pensioners is to be approved by the Sanjeevani helpline officials at the LHOs within "T+1 day". A dashboard showing pending position as at "T+3 days" is available to AGM (PPG) at the Circle level which needs to be closely monitored by them for observance of TAT (T+1 day).

5. Names of the Sanjeevani helpline officials for the purpose is to be approved by DGM & CDO at the Circle. HRMS department shall arrange for mapping necessary rights in HRMS for Sanjeevani helpline officials for approval and AGM (PPG) for monitoring.

4. Please bring the contents of the Circular to the knowledge of all concerned including pension paying branches to popularise the facility.

Standard Operating Procedure

Pensioners Video Life Certificate Submission – myHRMS App

(The facility is available to all those staff pensioners whose photographs are available on HRMS)

Stage 1 – Pensioner Module

- Pensioner login to myHRMS app
- Click on Life Certificate tab
- Select Offline submission
 - Select Record a Video
 - Answer questions asked during Video recording
 - Select Close and submit Video recording
 - Acknowledgement generated and displayed on screen

Stage 2 – Approval by Bank Officials

- The official (Sanjeevani nodal official) login in myHRMS app and select Approve LC menu.
- Approval
 - List of uploaded video recordings will be displayed
 - Official select a request and play video
 - Recorded video will be played on his myHRMS app and answers of the questions asked will be displayed on the screen
 - Official will view the video and verify the answers given by the pensioner with the answers displayed on the screen
 - Official will check pensioners PAN number displayed on screen
 - Official will match Pensioner's photo displayed on screen with the image displayed on video
 - In-case of any query, Official can call the pensioner from the same screen on myHRMS by clicking the call button and talk to pensioner and clear his/her doubt
 - Once satisfied the bank official Approves LC by clicking the approve button else rejects and give his remarks/comments
 - LC details are updated in HRMS. Video recording captured in HRMS for future reference
 - Email and SMS is sent to pensioner with remarks entered by official

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

EMANELMENT OF OFFICERS RETIRED IN SMGS-IV & V GRADE AS INVESTIGATING OFFICER (IO) ON CONTRACT BASIS WITHOUT PREJUDICE TO THEIR PENSION

LAST DATE OF SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION: 20.10.2024

Applications are invited from officers retired in SMGS-IV & V from SBI for empanelment as Investigating Officers (IO) in Chandigarh Circle to conduct Staff Accountability Exercise (SAE) in NPA Accounts.

2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR INVESTIGATING OFFICER (IO) IS AS UNDER:

- The retired officer should have retired from the Bank's service on attaining superannuation on or after 31.12.2021 as officer in the grades SMGS-IV/ V.
- The empanelment of an official will be terminated when he will attain 65 years of age or after 3 years of empanelment, whichever is earlier.
- The integrity of an official should not have been doubtful during his service in the Bank.
- No punishment/ penalty should have been inflicted on the official during five years of his service in the Bank preceding his retirement.
- No cases of CBI or other law enforcement agencies should be pending against the official.
- The officer/ employee should have retired from the bank's service only on attaining superannuation at the age of 60 years. The officer voluntarily retired/ resigned/ suspended or left the Bank otherwise before superannuation are not eligible for consideration for engagement. However, any officer, who has completed 58 years of age and 30 years of service/ pensionable service (both the conditions need to be satisfied) as on the date of applying for voluntary retirement as per e-Circular Nos. CDO/P&HRD-PM/58/2015-16 dated 07.10.2015 & CDO/P&HRD-PM/12/2017-18 dated 05.05.2017, will be eligible for engagement/ empanelment in the Bank on attaining the age of 60 years.
- The official should have sufficient experience in credit area.
- Ex-officers who are engaged in other organisations are not eligible for empanelment.
- The applicant should be maintaining good health and willing to travel to all places in the country.
- Pensioners presently drawing their pension from one Circle but residing permanently/ temporarily in the geographical area of other Circle may apply to

the Circle presently they are residing in. The pensioners shall not be eligible for empanelment in a Circle if they are presently neither residing nor drawing their pension from that Circle.

3. The brief role of Investigating Officers will be as under:

- To conduct Staff Accountability Examination (SAE) in NPA accounts with outstanding upto Rs. 50 Crores.
- The role of empanelled IO shall be restricted up to the stage of submission of SAE/ investigation report to the Authority ordering SAE/ investigation.
- The SAE/ investigation report should be a statement of facts and should not contain any recommendation.
- The standard format developed by BCDM Department will be utilized for submitting SAE/ investigation Report.
- The IO shall ensure that all documents and registers containing the evidences are retained in personal custody of Branch/ Unit Head having been entered in the Branch Document Register.
- The authority who is ordering investigation may assign other related roles as per requirement of a particular case.

4. Terms and conditions of the empanelment is attached as Annexure - I

5. Accordingly, all the retired officers who fulfil the above-mentioned eligibility criteria and are willing for the engagement/ empanelment as Investigating Officer (IO), are requested to submit their applications in the format attached as Annexure - I A.

6. Last date of receipt of applications through physical mode (Address: The Assistant General Manager (HR), State Bank of India, Local Head Office, Sector - 17 B, Chandigarh-160017) or at our e-mail ID cmrc.lhocha@sbi.co.in will be 20.10.2024.
